- Asphalt areas have been re-surfaced
- The Cox cable contract was successfully re-negotiated to slightly reduce our monthly fee to 60% of the 'rack rate' from 70%. The current rate negotiated means no dues or service changes for the year.
- HOA insurance quotes are being obtained (so far it looks like our current policy is in line with other estimates)
- No trespassing sign is in process of being put up at the top of the west cul de sac to prevent the general public from using the HOA owned hillside as a hiking/dog walking trail to the ridge
