Landscaping We are trying very hard to improve and take care of the Mirage Heights Property. Hal Rives, (owner of AAD Maintenance) was hired this past spring to be our new landscape company.

The landscapers come once a week on Wednesdays unless weather is a problem. Hal divided the property into three zones and works one zone per week.

We've had a few setbacks with the irrigation system this spring and summer, so we continue to work diligently with Hal to fix the problems. We hope to get it completed soon.

In addition we are also addressing the tree trimming which is needed throughout the property. Trimming the mature trees prevents damage to them during the monsoons or during any unexpected severe storm.
